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## PIPELINER FANCY WELDING CAP

The Pipeliner Fancy welding cap is the most popular welding cap I carry. Decorative stitches and a cotton sweatband make this personal and functional.

Choose any solid colored cotton fabric for your cap and decorative stitches will be sewn on the band and brim – I can choose the color or you can request a color. I have nearly 200 different colors of rayon and polyester embroidery thread for this special cap.

The welding cap will be lined with the color of fabric you chose for the welding cap.

### Brim Options:

- 2"

Custom Size, Depth or Other Requests are done at no extra cost.

Size is measured to the nearest 1/8"; Depth to the nearest 1/4".

I carry quite a few solid color cotton fabrics. Stock varies based on demand and supply.

The standard colors are as follows: Black, white, purple, brown, red, gray, navy, green, khaki, light blue, dark brown, and steel gray.

All fabrics are 100% cotton. Brim is lined with heavy weight pre-shrunk denim.

All fabrics are pre-shrunk to maintain the fit, size and shape wash after wash.

**Care:** Machine wash and dry with like colors.

Washing your caps to remove sweat, dirt and other debris keep your welding

caps looking great, fitting perfect and lasting

longer. I recommend not using dryer sheets

as these raise the fibers of the fabric which allows

it to attract dirt and sparks. Ironing the brim is

always a great choice.

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
